

## SAILING THE CYCLADES MYKONOS – MYKONOS

### 1st day: ARRIVAL IN MYKONOS / CHECK-IN

Arrival in Tourlos, the New Port of Mykonos where the sailing yacht is moored.

You will recognize the yacht by “Sunfos Alessia Yachting” yellow flag.

Check-in is from 5.00 p.m. Our skipper will greet you and give you all information concerning the local cruising grounds: the life on board, the navigation, the itinerary and important cohabitation tips. Overnight on board in Mykonos.

### 2nd day: MYKONOS / PAROS (approx.20 nautical miles)

We sail out of Mykonos to Naoussa located in a huge bay in the northern part of Paros.

Naoussa is famous for its numerous beautiful golden beaches such as *Kolymbithres and Monastiri*.

Stop for swimming and snorkeling.

Arrival in Naoussa where you will have time at disposal for touring and taking your dinner in one of the traditional fish tavernas. Overnight on board in Naoussa.

### 3rd day: PAROS / IRAKLIA (approx.20 nautical miles)

Departure for Iraklia which belongs to the group of islands known as the small Cyclades and with only 115 inhabitants. Iraklia has two villages: *Panagia*, located in the centre of the island, and *Agios Georgios*, which serves as the main port. Iraklia has many beautiful beaches around its coastline. Some of these can be visited on foot but the most impressive is *Livadi*, a long sandy beach with crystal water, on the eastern side of the island. The beach of *Agios Georgios* gets more popular due to its closeness to the port. Time at disposal for swimming and snorkeling. Overnight on board in Iraklia.

### 4th day: IRAKLIA / SCHINOUSA (approx.3 nautical miles)

Today we sail to Schinoussa, the tiny and remote island with 17 beaches. The capital village is *Chora* located on the hill with a beautiful panorama and tavernas with typical Greek cuisine. The most popular beaches are *Almyros, Livadi, Tsigouri and Mersini*. Free time for swimming and snorkeling. Overnight on board in Schinoussa.

### 5th day: SCHINOUSA / KOUFONISI (approx.8 nautical miles)

At the southeast of Naxos and within a short distance lie Koufonissia, a small group of two islands, Pano and Kato Koufonissi and are separated by a short channel of about 200m. Both islands are famous for their exotic beaches. Time at disposal for swimming and snorkeling. Overnight on board in Pano Koufonissi.

### 6th day:: KOUFONISI / NAXOS ( approx.20 nautical miles )

Today we sail to Naxos, the largest and the most fertile island of the Cyclades. Naxos with its great variety offers impressive mountainous landscapes, some of the most beautiful golden sandy beaches like *Mikri Vigla, Plaka* or *Agios Prokopios*, a charming capital with its Venetian quarter, picturesque fishing villages, many Byzantine churches, ruins and active night life. Time at disposal to visit the island or to swim. Overnight on board in Naxos.

### 7th day: NAXOS / MYKONOS (approx.22 nautical miles)

Today we sail to Mykonos one of the group of the Cyclades famous for the beautiful white sandy beaches, the small white houses with blue painted doors, the windmills, the numerous small churches and the active night life. Time at disposal to visit the island and for swimming.

Overnight on board in Mykonos.

### 8th day: MYKONOS / CHECK-OUT

Check-out is at 9.00 a.m. You can extend your stay in Mykonos or proceed to your next destination.

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
